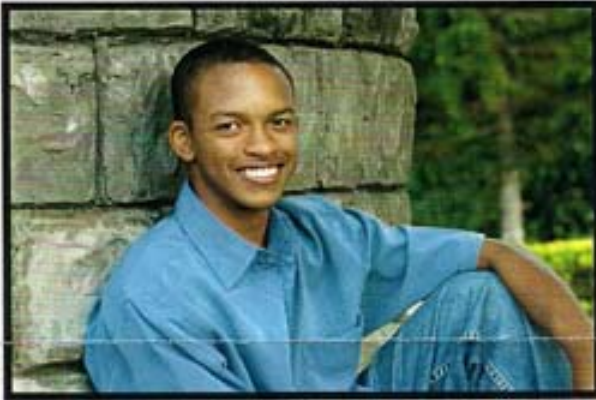

## The Brooks Family at the Crossroad of Their Calling In Missions

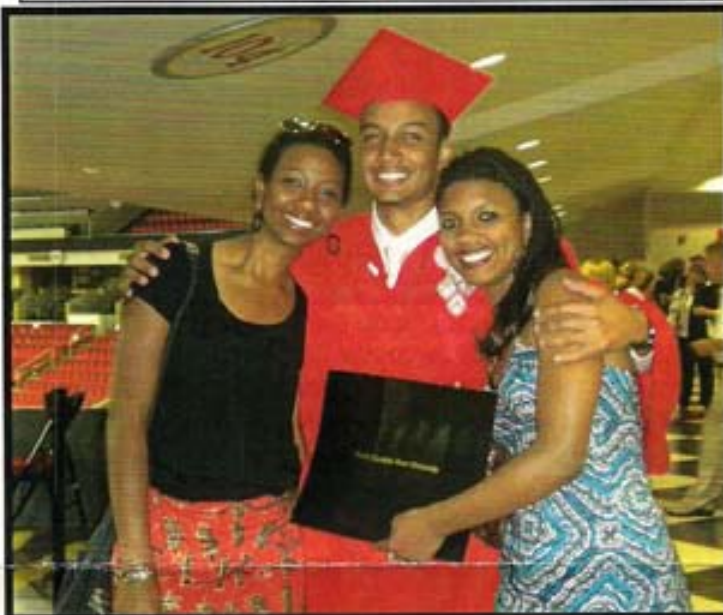


Jeremy graduated from Hillcrest International School in Papua Indonesia. He will attend North Carolina State University in the fall and major in Computer Engineering.

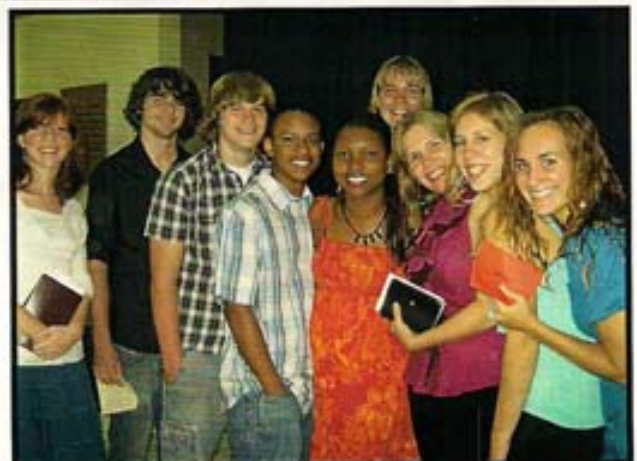
