Some important information concerning Mount Hope's trip to Haiti:

- The purpose of this trip is to be the hands and feet of Jesus to those who are in need. Our prayer is not only that others might come to know Christ as we serve, but that we also would be drawn closer to the Lord as we love as He has called us to love.
- This trip will be in conjunction with Praying Pelican Missions (www.prayingpelicanmissions.org). Our youth worked with this organization in Belize and we went to Haiti through Praying Pelican in 2010 and they were excellent.
- An informational meeting will take place on **Sunday, October 9th** after the 2nd service and again on **Wednesday, October 12th** at 6:00 p.m. If you are interested in going, please plan to attend one of these two meetings.
- In order to secure a spot on the trip a \$250.00 deposit must be turned in by **Sunday, October 30th**. Also, please begin the Passport process (if need be) and speak with a travel clinic ASAP.
- The overall cost of the trip will be somewhere between \$1800.00 and \$2000.00 and any fundraising will be the individual's responsibility.
 - \$1125.00 per person will cover the cost of a hotel, food, and building materials (\$300.00 per person) for the week.
 - The biggest variable will be the cost of plane tickets. Expedia shows that we could book flights today for under \$650.00 a person, however, we cannot book flights until we have solid commitments from group members. We will wait to book flights until the first week of November.
- This will not be an easy trip. It is always a stretch to leave our comfort zones and experience another culture, however it will be extremely rewarding. There are a number of work options. Most of the work will involve physical labor. There is the possibility of some other opportunities (i.e. visiting an orphanage, or medical work), but we won't know all of the details until closer to our departure date.
- This trip is only open to adults and youth ninth grade and up.
