

# HAITI

## OCTOBER 30TH - NOVEMBER 5TH, 2010

### *Preliminary information concerning Mount Hope's trip to Haiti:*

- The purpose of this trip is to be the hands and feet of Jesus to those who are in need. Our prayer is not only that others might come to know Christ as we serve, but that we also would be drawn closer to the Lord as we love as He has called us to love.
- This trip will be in conjunction with Praying Pelican Missions ([www.prayingpelicanmissions.org](http://www.prayingpelicanmissions.org)). Our youth worked with this organization in Belize and they were excellent.
- In order to secure a spot on the trip a \$100.00 deposit and the Praying Pelican registration form must be turned in by **Sunday, February 28th**. Also, please begin the Passport process (if need be) and speak with a travel clinic ASAP.
- The overall cost of the trip will be somewhere between \$1500.00 and \$2000.00 and any fundraising will be the individual's responsibility.
  - \$895.00 per person will cover the cost of living, food, and building materials for the week.
  - The biggest variable will be the cost of plane tickets. Expedia shows that we could book flights today for under \$400.00 a person, however, we cannot book flights until we have solid commitments from group members. We will wait to book flights until early March or when all the spaces are filled.
- This will not be an easy trip. Living conditions will require that we bring our own mattresses, and bedding, and we will be sleeping on the floor. It is unknown at this time what level of bathroom and shower facilities will be available to us.
- This will be a physical trip. Most of the work we will be doing will be construction work. There is the possibility of some other opportunities (i.e. visiting an orphanage, or medical work), but we won't know until this summer what they are.
- This trip is only open to adults 18+, unless a parent and an older child would like to go together.
- There are 25 spots available for this trip on a first-come basis. We can take less than 25 people, but we cannot take more than 25.
