Bullying is not just physical. In fact, it is almost never physical. It is usually verbal.

In these upcoming weeks we will be looking at the biblical faith based solution to bullying. I am very excited about this topic and as I go through the curriculum I am becoming more and more passionate about this epidemic.

In the passage above Jesus says, the second greatest commandment after loving God is to "Love your neighbor as yourself". The problem is there are so many people out there that don't even love themselves. It makes it virtually impossible to love someone else when

you don't love yourself.

It would be naive of me to think that bullying doesn't happen within our own youth group. The reality is that bullying happens everywhere. We have students in revolution that one day may be a victim of bullying and the next week they are the bully.

As we go through this curriculum our students will hear true stories from students their own age about their experiences with bullying. They will also see first-hand the "power of two". When two or more people stand up for a victim of bullying, the situation is most often diffused.

This is a great curriculum to kick the school year off with. It is my prayer that our students would start this school year more prepared than ever before!

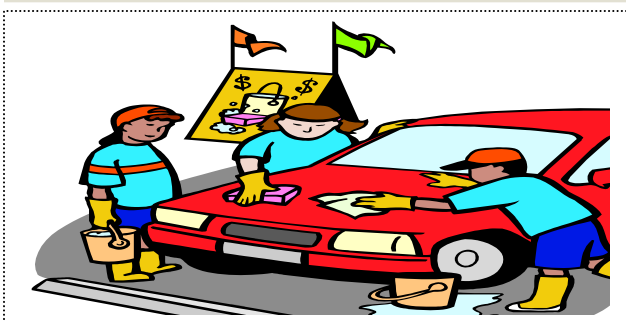
